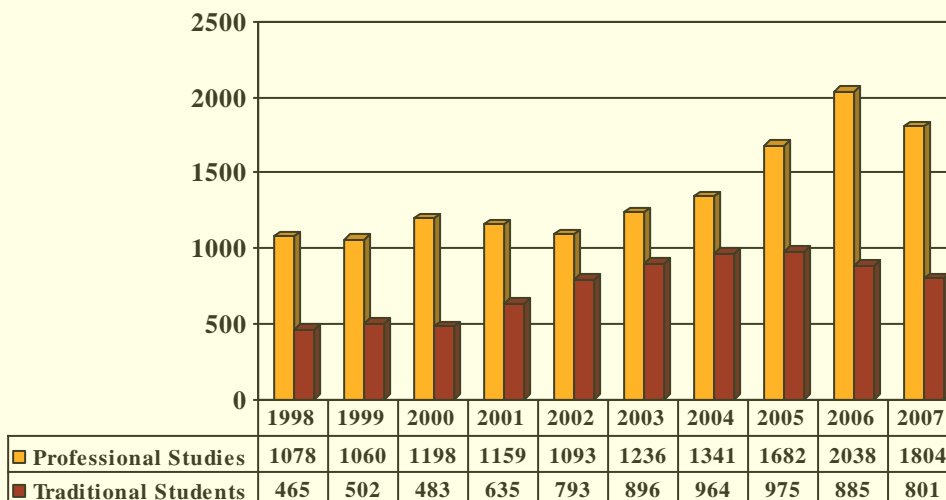

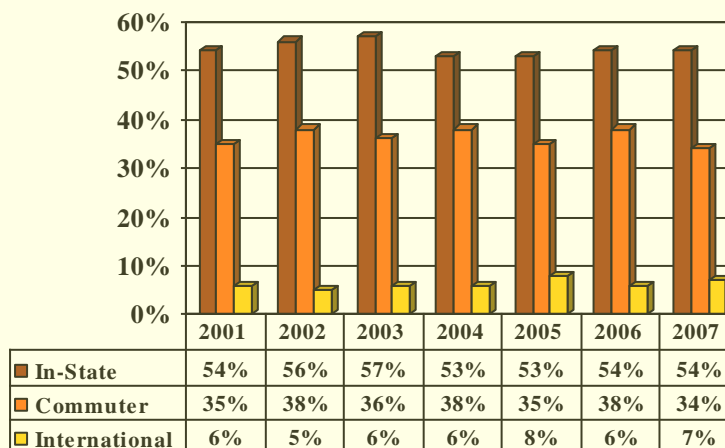

Traditional College Enrollment History



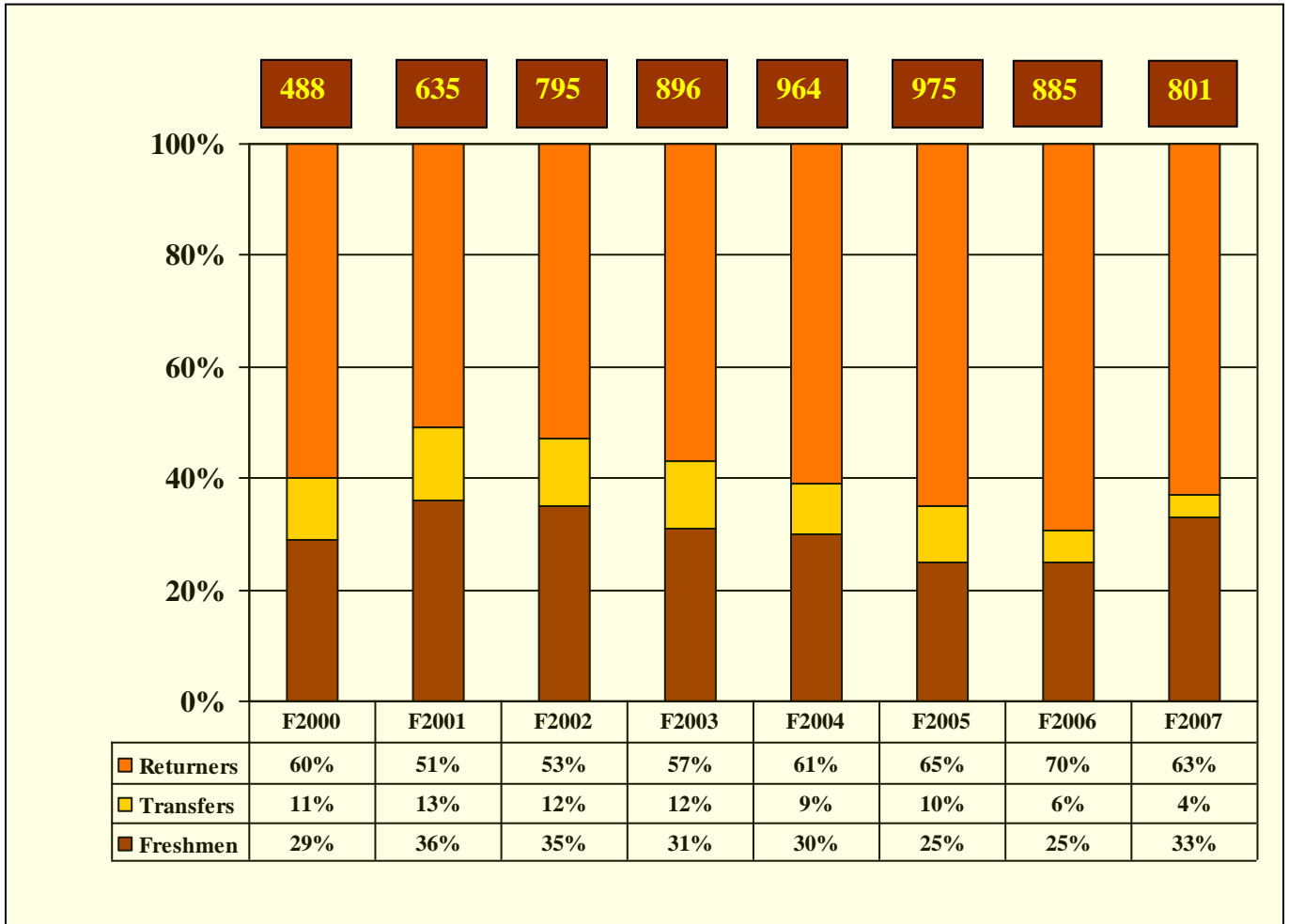

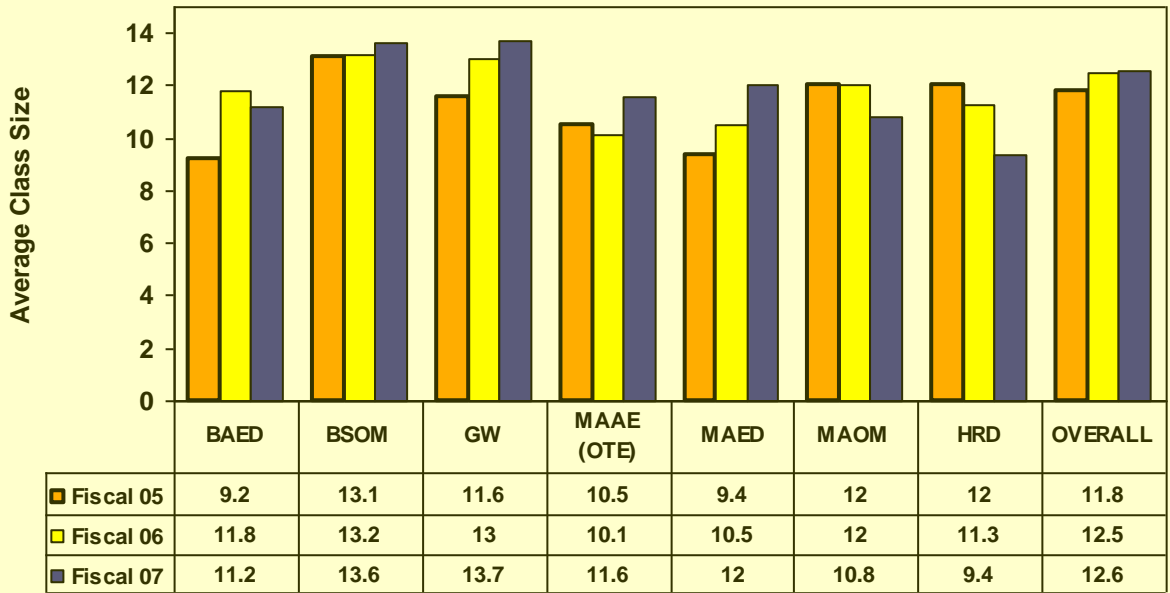

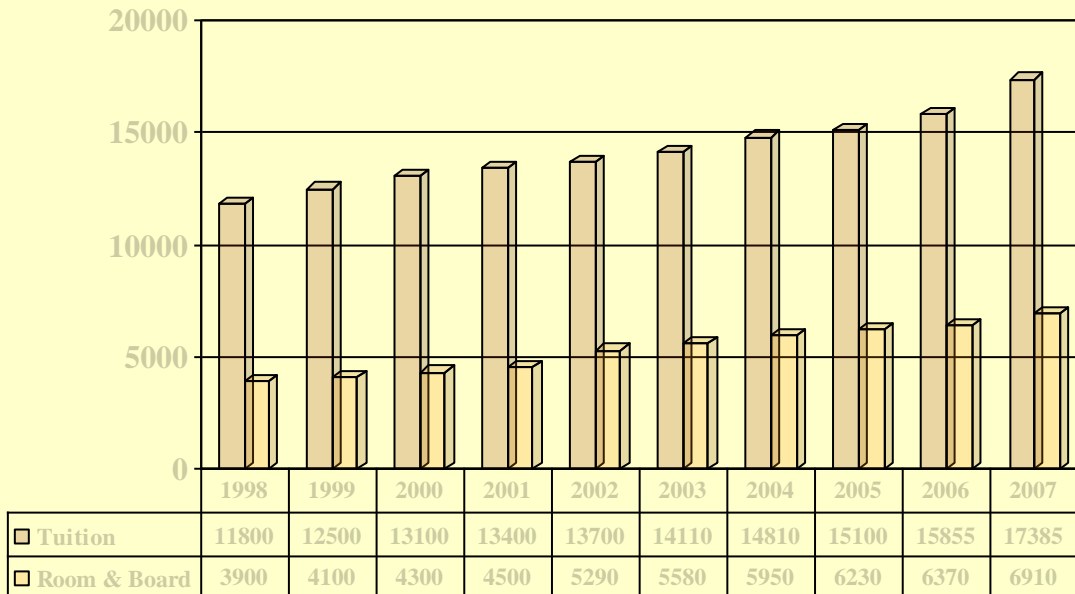
Traditional College Class Size



Average Class Sizes GPS

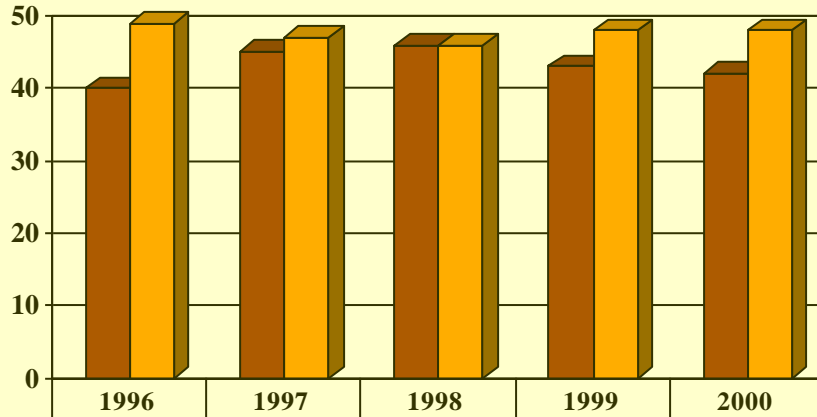


Tuition, Room & Board Traditional Program



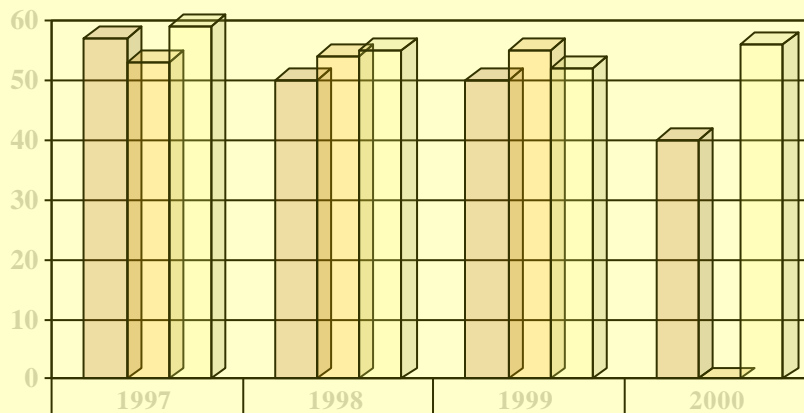
