Please choose one submission from one of the categories below. We will only judge one submission. In celebration of Old Oak, we encourage you to let East Tennessee living influence your submissions.

(Please announce author and title of chosen play at the beginning of the video.) Write an essay detailing your interest in design and technical theater. (1,000 word minimum)
MUSIC	
Submit:	 Send a video recording of candidate performing a short piece of music (2-5 minutes). Pieces need not be original compositions.
