Thank you for your interest in the Educational Talent Search Program. I encourage you to take time to familiarize yourself with the program as my colleagues and I would be honored to serve you and your family.

- Educational Talent Search (known in many schools simply as Talent Search) is a Federal TRIO Program of the U.S. Department of Education and is locally sponsored by Tusculum University. Talent Search serves students in Carter, Cocke, Greene, and Unicoi counties in grades 6-12.
- The main goal of the program is to assist students by providing college information and academic advising services with the intent they continue their education beyond high school. These services include test-taking strategies, study skills, career awareness, ACT preparation, financial-aid assistance, college application assistance, and tutoring.
- All Talent Search services are <u>FREE</u>! Talent Search pays for one ACT exam, provides college visits during the school year, and offers various educational and cultural trips during the summer months.

There is no charge for participation in the Educational Talent Search Program. However, students interested in the program are <u>required</u> to submit a completed application in order to be considered for selection. In order to comply with federal regulations, the Talent Search application is thorough and does require some personal family information. <u>This information is kept confidential and is not shared.</u>
